

WHO IS ELIGIBLE FOR TRANSITION TO WORK

- » A school leaver who has completed year 12 and has an intellectual, psychiatric or sensory disability
- » Has been assessed as eligible by ADHC
- » Lives in NSW
- » A person who wishes to participate in a program that will support his or her future work or study goals

The Transition to Work program assists young people with a disability to **develop skills and independence** to **maximise employment** goals and sustain ongoing **workplace learning and development**, as well as support for an independent lifestyle.

Challenge offer the Transition to Work program over a number of different dynamics. **This includes group activities and individual goal orientated programs.**

The programs are **tailored to assist individuals** achieve their goals; the primary objective is work focused skill development and associated training.

Young people who access this service are **encouraged and supported** through work place sampling and job trials in order to gain industry knowledge to progress within their chosen field. Young people are then intensely supported to achieve sustainable employment. **The program also provides support in areas of personal and social development.**
