COURSE DETAILS

Course Duration

The expected time to complete this course is 8 months. Students will receive a timetable outlining the workshop dates upon enrollment of the course.

Course Delivery

The delivery of this course will be comprised of face to face workshops, workplace activities and written assignments to be completed between the workshops. Learning materials will be provided to students on day 1 of the course.

Recognised Prior Learning (RPL)

Recognition of prior learning offers students an opportunity to be recognised for existing training and industry experience they have gained which relates to the units in this course. This means students may be exempt from certain units and will only undertake training and assessment in the areas where further development is needed.
